Unit 1 : Intro to Java

Assignment 1

Make a program that has two variables, and integer (int) and a String. (*Strings are any text that are in " ", like words, sentences ...*).

- Create the variables
- Assign a value to them
- Print them out
- Change the values
- Print them out again

Example of output:

Alexis is 30 years old

Alexa is <mark>31</mark> years old

or

- I have <mark>20 dollars</mark>.
- I have 99 bottles of beer.
- > To print text, enclose it in quotes: System.out.println("Hey there");
- To join text to numbers or variables, use a + (ie. concatenation)
 System.out.println("My name is " + name);
- ► Do not enclose variable names in " " if you want the contents of the variables to be printed out.
